We also affirm that the 1928 Book of Common Prayer reflects the Bible on worship and teaching. The 39 Articles of Religion, contained in the prayer book, stand in defense against man's attempt to alter God's truth.



## 1928 BOOK OF COMMON PRAYER

**W**e worship our Lord with the 1928 Book of Common Prayer for two reasons:

- ◆ By adhering to the doctrines and practices set out in the prayer book, we are less likely to be influenced by the ideas of either a single person or group.
- ◆ It keeps us away from false ideas or over-emphasizing a single part of Christ's teach. The book acts as a guide to keep us in balance with scripture, sermon and prayers. It does not replace the Holy Bible.
